

RoHS Compliance Statement

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS), Directive (EU) 2015/863, restricts the use of hazardous substances as part of the European Union's horizontal hazardous waste legislation. The substances, which are restricted, are as follows:

As Groschopp is a downstream user and not a raw material manufacturer, we are reliant on our upstream suppliers for the information relating to RoHS compliance. Where our suppliers have given their statements as a letter of intention, this is not legally binding so we ourselves cannot sign a legally binding document on such a basis. In any case, by accepting our order, our suppliers confirm to deliver only RoHS compliant raw materials. Additionally, please note that we do not routinely analyze our suppliers' products for non-intentionally added substances.
